DISCIPLINE



- **Form of teaching, not punishment.**

(Paraan ng pagturo, hindi pagparusa)

- **Train someone to obey rules or follow expected behavior.**

(Sanayin ang isang tao na sumunod sa mga panuntunan o pagsunod sa tamang pag-uugali.)

HOW TO DISCIPLINE

STEP 1: BE SWIFT AND SAFE

- **Correct the misbehavior quickly by processing what happened**

(Itama ang maling nagawa agad sa pamamagitan ng pagproseso sa nangyari)

“What happened?”

“Why did you _____?”

“Are we supposed to _____?”

- **When talking to the student, make sure to move into a safe place to help them feel more calm and ready to listen**

(Kapag kakausapin ang mga estudyante, siguraduhing lumipat sa isang ligtas na lugar upang matulungan silang maging mas kalmado at handa na makinig)



HOW TO DISCIPLINE

STEP 2: REDIRECT ENERGY

- **When a child is roaming around the classroom, you may redirect his energy into something positive**

(Kapag ang bata ay nagiikot sa silid-aralan, mari mong i-direkta ang kanyang enerhiya sa ibng mga positibong bagay)

"Can you help me _____?"

"Can you please get the _____?"

- **When a child is insisting to do something else, ask them to do the assigned task first**

(Kapag ang bata ay nagiikot sa silid-aralan, mari mong i-direkta ang kanyang enerhiya sa ibng mga positibong bagay)

HOW TO DISCIPLINE

STEP 3: GIVE REWARDS AND CONSEQUENCES

- **When a child did a great job, don't forget to commend him**
(Kapag may nagawang tama ang bata, huwag kakalimutang puritan sila)
"Wow! Good Job!"
"Very Good"
"Thank you for _____!"
- **When a child did something wrong, make sure to ask the teacher what consequence to give**
(Kapag ang isang bata ay nagkamali, siguraduhing itanong sa guro kung ano ang gagawin sa bata)
"Remember, teacher said you need to sit down first before you can play outside"
"Teacher said you cannot get another toy unless you finish packing away"



THINGS TO REMEMBER



- **Hitting is not allowed**
(Ang pananakit ay ipinagbabawal)
- **Be a good role model**
(Maging mabuting ehemplo)
- **Practice what you preach**
(Gawin ang iyong mga ipinangangaral)
- **Talk to the students calmly**
(Kausapin ang mga bata nang mahinahon)
